

Historic Milestones

1836: Frank Potts came to South Australia on HMS Buffalo when the new colony of South Australia was founded.

1850: Frank Potts purchased the first sections in Langhorne Creek, consisting of 217 acres.


1858: Planted Shiraz and Verdelho as the first grapes in the Langhorne Creek

1892: Frank Potts II built the Bleasdale Red Gum Press, now listed on the National Trust of South Australia register.

1961: Release first red table wine; a single varietal Malbec.

2017: Paul Hotker, Senior Winemaker, wins Halliday Winemaker of the Year.

2019: Bleasdale wins Australia's most prestigious wine award - the Jimmy Watson Trophy.

UNIQUE POINTS – LANGHORNE Creek

 Langhorne Creek has a unique maritime microclimate caused from proximity to Lake Alexandrina

Southerly winds blowing directly from the Southern Ocean across Lake Alexandrina during the growing season reduce daytime temperature fluctuations, helping the grapes to maintain great complexity and flavour.

 Vineyards on the banks of the Bremer River can use a unique method of flood irrigation implemented whenever the Bremer River bursts its banks, with a system of floodgates in place to divert the water through vineyards



Bleasdale's vineyards

- 55.5 hectares of Estate vineyards, including Cabernet Sauvignon, Shiraz, and Malbec
- A number of multi-generational local growers supporting the community
- Oldest Estate vines planted 1930
- Participant in EcoVinyeards project where native insectary species are planted to reduce input costs and the use of chemicals
- Yields averaging between 5.8t/ha to 10t/ha, dependent on variety
