WINEMAKER NOTES

WITH DEEP ALLUVIAL FLOODPLAINS AND THE MARITIME INFLUENCE OF LAKE ALEXANDRINA, LANGHORNE CREEK IS HOME TO SOME OF AUSTRALIA'S BEST SOILS AND GROWING CONDITIONS. FRANK POTTS REALISED THIS WHEN HE ESTABLISHED BLEASDALE IN 1850. THE ICONIC MULBERRY TREE VINEYARD, NAMED AFTER THE ANCIENT TREE THAT GROWS ADJACENT TO THE VINEYARD ON THE BANK OF THE BREMER RIVER, CONSISTENTLY PRODUCES FRUIT OF EXCEPTIONAL QUALITY.

THIS IS AN ELEGANT CABERNET SAUVIGNON WITH INTENSE AROMAS OF MIXED BERRIES, WOODY HERBS, DARK CHOCOLATE AND VIOLETS. THE PALATE IS SMOOTH AND PERSISTENT, WITH BLACKCURRANT AND SPICY OAK FLAVORS, BEFORE FINISHING WITH SOFT AND SUBTLE TANNINS.
