

The Raconteur is sourced from, Margaret River and The Great Southern Elegant and beautifully-balanced multi-regional WA Cabernet Pressed into some 20% new French oak barriques to finish fermentation before maturation for 18 months in the same oak.

The Raconteur typifies medium-bodied and European in style, get ready for the aroma to leap from the glass with violets and black berry and mocha notes. Along with lip-smacking tannins and fine oak nuances, the Raconteur can easily be enjoyed on immediate opening or be cellared for up to 10 years and is absolutely a must with roast lamb, chargrilled ribeye and/or array of cheeses.

Margaret River and The Great Southern
Blend Detail 54% Margaret River 46% Great Southern

Margaret River from Knotting Hill Vineyard Located on Miamup Rd Wilyabrup (very close to Fraser Gallop/The Grove/Woody Nook vineyards)

Elevation 20 - 60m

Northeast aspect

Houghton's Clone Cabernet Sauvignon

Vine age 32 yrs

Great Southern from Montgomery's Vineyard

Elevation 50m

Northern aspect

Clone Cabernet Sauvignon WA selection

Vine age 18yrs

Machine harvested using 'Selective' harvester which eliminates leaf matter and bunch stems

Crushed/destemmed into open topped fermenters.

Fermentation cap management by pump over.

Pressed at dryness in air bag press.

MLF inoculated and completed in barrel

100% French oak, 20% new with balance 1,2 and 3 years old.

15 months in oak
